Shirish Sathaye joined Matrix Partners in 2001. His first investment was a wireless enterprise networking company called Aruba Networks, which he helped incubate in Matrix Partners' Silicon Valley office. The company went public in March 2007. Prior to joining Matrix Shirish worked for Alteon Websystems, a Server-Load-Balancer and Content-switching company backed by Matrix, as its vice president of engineering and later, its chief technology officer. Alteon went public in 1999 and the next year sold to Nortel for \$7.8 billion. Previously Shirish ran engineering for the ATM switch group at FORE Systems. He earned a BS in electronics engineering from the Indian Institutes of Technology, IT-BHU, an MS in Electrical Engineering from Virginia Tech and a PhD in Electrical and Computer Engineering from Carnegie Mellon University.
